Opened in the fall of 1995, Second Presbyterian Church's Memorial Garden allows parishioners to rest next to the spiritual home they loved in life or to honor loved ones with an bronze plaque placed on the Memorial Walls.

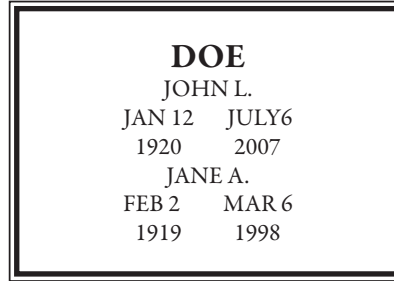
Nestled in the shadow of the Spire, outside the east wall of the Sanctuary, this beautiful and consecrated place incorporates Indiana limestone and Italian granite with tasteful landscaping, walks and benches to create a lovely retreat for generations to come. Initially, the Memorial Garden was built with 540 plaques and 144 niches. In the summer of 2007, an additional 112 niches were made available.

Perpetual maintenance is assured through the Business Affairs Committee of Session.

Every year, a service is held in the Garden prior to Memorial Day offering loved ones the opportunity to gather in prayer, remembrance, and thanksgiving.

Niches

Each niche holds one or two urns and displays a bronze plaque inscribed with the name(s) and dates of birth and death of the deceased.



What is the size of the niche?

Each niche is 12x12x12 inches. Your funeral home will need this information in order to help you choose an urn (or urns) of the appropriate size.

What does the niche purchase price of \$2500 include?

Each niche, suitable for one or two urns, includes one inscribed 10x12 plaque, and the opening and sealing at time of inurnment. Perpetual maintenance also is provided.

Memorial Plaques

Bronze memorial plaques honor loved ones buried elsewhere. Plaques are 12x4 and may be purchased for \$400 each.
