You call us to fight pretensions and injustice, but we sit idly by, endangering the lives of people far and near.



#### **Constitutional Questions to the Candidate**

Will you in your own life seek to follow the Lord Jesus Christ, love your neighbors, and work for the reconciliation of the world? **I will.** 

Do you promise to further the peace, unity, and purity of the church? **I do.** 

Will you pray for and seek to serve the people with energy, intelligence, imagination, and love? I will.

Will you be a faithful teaching elder, proclaiming the good news in Word and Sacrament, teaching faith and caring for people? Will you be active in government and discipline, serving in the councils of the church; and in your ministry will you try to show the love and justice of Jesus Christ? I will.


